JUVENILE RUN OVER BY PARADE FLOAT AFTER CHRISTMAS PARADE

Bradley County, TN (December 6, 2025) — The Bradley County Sheriff's Office is investigating an incident that occurred in the parking lot of Bradley Central High School following the Annual Christmas Parade.

A juvenile participant riding on a parade float fell from the float as it was negotiating a low-speed turn in the parking lot at the high school. After falling, the juvenile was run over by the tires of the float.

Deputies and emergency medical personnel on scene responded immediately. The juvenile was alert and conscious at the scene and was transported to a local hospital for further evaluation.

Due to the age of the individual involved, the juvenile's name is being withheld at this time. Additional information will be released as it becomes available.
